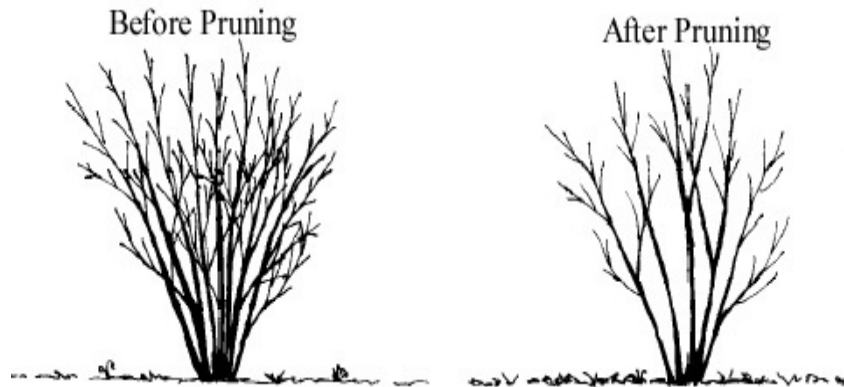

## Winter Pruning of Trees and Shrubs
